With March Madness approaching, student-athletes and institutional staff members (who have responsibilities with the athletic department) are reminded of the following NCAA regulations pertaining to sports wagering and gambling

Sports Wagering: This includes placing, accepting, or soliciting a wager of any kind with any individual or organization on any intercollegiate, amateur, or professional sporting events.

- Internet sport wagering (Draft Kings)
- Super Bowl squares that require an entry fee
- Auctions in which bids are placed on teams, individuals, or contests
- Pools or fantasy leagues in which an entry fee is required

Consequences of Sports Wagering:

- Sports Wagering can possibly result in termination of position or loss of student-athlete's eligibility in all sports.
